### **“The development of the principles of “Parteiengehör” and “Rechtsverfahren” by the Verwaltungsgerichtshof during the Austro- Hungarian Empire.”**

The European dimension of administrative law is the focus of a flurry of initiatives aiming to investigate similarities and differences in order to shape common legal scenarios among the Member States of the EU. Therefore, it is important to understand whether the method traditionally followed by the European Court of Justice in the course of identifying the principles that are common to national legal systems, only applies when each of those systems recognize such principles. Additionally arising issues are, whether national systems of public law share the same idea of what an administrative procedure is and whether the specific principles governing administrative procedures are common among those national systems.

#### **The speakers:**

**Prof. Dr. Giacinto della Cananea** has been awarded an advanced grant by the European Research Council for the research project on “The Common Core of European Administrative Laws” in 2016, for a period of five years. In 2018 he received the first prize in the Spinelli Outreach Prize for the work concerning the codification of administrative procedures published by ReNEUAL.

**Prof. Dr. Angela Ferrari Zumbini** is currently Tenured Assistant Professor in Administrative Law at the University of Naples “Federico II”. She is in charge of carrying out the research on the Austrian administrative jurisprudence in the years 1890-1910 and will focus on the influence of the Austrian General Law on Administrative Procedure.
